Under Title 6 the employee is to be paid the prevailing wage for the job to which he is hired up to \$500.00 per month. The Professional Service Employee is to be paid within a range of \$500.00 minimum to \$10,000.00 maximum, or the prevailing wage for his position. Under the Professional Service Employee program the employer is asked to make provision in his budget to employ the Professional Service Employee for the year following his employment under this program. The County is not obligated to provide insurance or retirement Hunt County will provide insurance and retirement for the Professional Service Employee. for the Title 6 employee or the Professional Service Employee. County offices wishing to employ individuals under these programs are to make their requests through the County Judge's Office.

Commissioner Roy L. Holder nominated Commissioner James A. Speight as representative to the Manpower Planning Advisory Committee presently coordinated by the North Central Texas Council of Governments.
