

COMMISSIONERS' COURT MINUTES FEBRUARY 10, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session Monday February 10, 1975 at 10:00 am in the Commissioners' Courtroom, second floor Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Roy L. Holder.

37 Bids were submitted on the Hunt County Depository from Colonial Bank, First Greenville National Bank and Citizens National Bank of Greenville. Motion was made by Johnnie H. Lyon, and seconded by James A. Speight to accept the bid of First Greenville National Bank for the Hunt County Depository. Motion carried with Commissioners Lyon, Holder and Speight voting AYE and Commissioner Grimes voting NO.

Minutes for January 31, 1975 were read and approved.

38 On a motion of Henry L. Grimes, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court accepted the bid of Wallace Hefner Sheet Metal & Roofing to repair the roof of the Courthouse, the bid being in the amount of \$2350.00. All present voting AYE.

39 At the request of County School Superintendent Mrs. Jessie Miller, the Court unanimously approved the calling of a County School Board Election for Saturday April 5, 1975 to elect three members to the Board from Commissioner Precincts 1 and 2 and the County-at-large. Motion was made by Judge Terrell and seconded by Roy L. Holder.

40 Juvenile Probation Officer Dixon Latham came before the Court requesting authorization to add five positions to the payroll of the Juvenile Probation Office in the form of intake workers for the Juvenile Detention Center. On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court approved the addition of Mike Abbott, John D. Scott, Karl P. Hibchen, Vickie McCarty and Darla Salling to the payroll as part-time employees at a salary of \$100.00 per month plus \$2.00 per hour as of February 1, 1975. All present voting AYE.

41 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court granted Tax Cancellation Certificates numbers 9 through 19 with all members present voting AYE.

42 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court voted to sell used equipment in Precinct 1, accepting the high bid of Jimmy Williams on a 1971  $\frac{1}{2}$  ton Ford pick-up in the amount of \$1,018.50, the high bid of C. J. Ray on a John Deere post hole digger in the amount of \$45.00 and the high bid of L. J. Reagan on a 1963 Ford winch truck in the amount of \$275.00. All other bids were rejected. Motion carried with all present voting AYE.

Court recessed at 11:25 A.M. in order to further examine monthly accounts.

Court reconvened at 11:55 A. M. in the Commissioners' Courtroom with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

43 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Henry L. Grimes the Court unanimously approved the accounts for the month of January 1975. Balance of accounts is as follows:
