

COMMISSIONERS' COURT MINUTES, SPECIAL SESSION, MARCH 24, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioners' Court met in Special Session, Monday March 24, 1975 at 1:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Courtroom, second floor, Hunt County Courthouse with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

75 On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court voted unanimously to approve a resolution supporting legislation regarding an increase of car registration handling fees. A copy of this resolution being recorded in the Minutes of the Court.


76 Roy Randolph, Chief Deputy, Sheriff's Office, came before the Court representing the Sheriff's Office to inform the Court of the need for a deep freeze for the jail. The Freezer now in the jail would require from approximately \$150.00 to \$200.00 to repair. Mr. Randolph presented a price list from local firms to the Court for consideration of the purchase of a new freezer. Motion was made by Henry L. Grimes and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to purchase a 20 cubic foot freezer from Montgomery Ward at a price of \$274.43 with immediate delivery. Motion was defeated with Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon and Henry L. Grimes voting AYE. Commissioners Roy L. Holder and James A. S peight voted NO. Judge Ed Terrell voted NO.

77 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder and seconded by James A. Speight to purchase a 22 cubic foot freezer from Sears at a price of \$279.95 with 3 day delivery. Commissioners Roy L. Holder and James A. Speight voted AYE. Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon and Henry L. Grimes voted NO. Judge Ed Terrell voted AYE. Motion carried.

There being no further business Judge Ed Terrell adjourned the Court.
