

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Special Session, Friday May 23, 1975 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas, with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by County Attorney Richard W. Carter.

Minutes of the May 12, 1975 Regular Session were read and approved.

122 On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court approved right of way requests by Southwestern Bell Telephone Co. in Commissioner Precinct 2 with the stipulation cables be placed on back slopes of roads and the County will not be responsible for damages done to roads. Motion carried with all members present voting AYE.

123 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court unanimously approved the following personnel changes in the Juvenile Probation Office: Ms. Vickie McCarty was removed from the payroll; Ms. Debra Ennis was added to the payroll as a parttime employee effective May 12, 1975 at a salary of \$2.00 per hour; Mr. Jeff White was added to the payroll as a part-time employee effective May 2, 1975 at \$2.00 per hour; and Ms. Sheila Fisk was added to the payroll as a part-time employee effective May 23, 1975 at \$2.00 per hour.

124 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court unanimously approved the installation of an extension telephone in the Juvenile Probation Office.

125 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court voted to rescind Order # 110 of May 12, 1975 adding Mr. Donald Parks to the County Payroll. Mr. Parks will be retained by the County Attorney's Office as Administrative Assistant under the Professional Service Employee program with Hunt County to continue Mr. Parks' insurance and retirement benefits. All members of the Court voting AYE.

126 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court unanimously approved three payroll changes in Commissioner precinct 3: those changes being the rehiring of Mr. Hoyt Scarbrough at a salary of \$473.50 per month; the addition of Billy Stewart as a summer employee at \$2.25 per hour; and the addition of Neal Dunlap as a summer employee at \$2.25 per hour.

There being no further business, Judge Ed Terrell adjourned the Court.
