The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session, Monday June 9, 1975 at 10:00 a .m . in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Roy L. Holder.

Minutes of the May 23, 1975 Special Session were read and approved.

- 131 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court voted to accept for filing as revised, the Revised Plat of part of Club Terrace Subdivision owned by Mr. J. D. McCaghren with the stipulation any controversy will be worked out between Mr. McCaghren and the property owners. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.
- On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court approved the corrected revised Flat of Whisker's Retreat Installment VI with the stipulation any controversy will be worked out between Mr. Sawyers and the property owners. Motion carried with all members present voting AYE.
- 133 On a motion by James A. S peight, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court unanimously granted the following payroll changes: Mr. John McCloud was removed from the Payroll of Commissioner Precinct 1 effective May 31, 1975; Mr. W. E. Howell was added to the payroll of Commissioner Precinct 2 as a part-time summer employee at \$2.25 per hour; Mr. Tommy Passons was removed from the payroll of Commissioner Precinct 3 effective Friday June 6, 1975; and Mr. Leslie W. Cox was added to the payroll of Commissioner Precinct 3 at \$2.25 per hour effective June 9, 1975.
- 134 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court voted to set a Public Hearing for Friday June 20, 1975 at 10:00 a.m. to discuss proposed regulations concerning subdivisions. Motion carried with all members present voting AYE.
- 135 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court unanimously agreed to take under advisement the proposed contract for a Child Welfare Board, as presented to the Court by County Attorney Richard W. Carter.
- 136 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder, and seconded by James A. Speight to grant a right of way request by Continental Telephone Company in Commissioner Precinct 3 with the stipulation cables be placed on back slopes of roads and the County will not be responsible for damages done to roads. Motion carried with all members present voting AYE.

Judge Ed Terrell moved the following resolution be approved:

Whereas: Hunt County has many loyal and faithful employees who have served the Citizens of this county for many years; and

Whereas: No means has been provided for additional compensation for longevity of service: Therefore

Be It Resolved: That each employee with 1 to 5 years service be allowed 10 days vacation time, that each employee with 5 to 10 years continuous service be allowed 12 days vacation time, that each employee with 10 to 15 years continuous service be allowed 13 days vacation time and that employees with 15 or more years continuous service be allowed 15 days vacation time.

Motion to approve this resolution was seconded by Roy L. Holder.

After further discussion, a motion was made by Johnnie H. Lyon and seconded by Henry L. Grimes to amend the original motion by Judge Terrell to delay action until a later date. Commissioner Johnnie H. Lyon, Henry L. Grimes, and James A. Speight voted AYE; Commissioner Roy L. Holder and Judge Ed Terrell voted NO. Motion Carried.

On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court approved for filing the plat of Wranglers Rest as presented to the Court by Mr. D. M. Sawyers with the stipulation the County will not maintain any existing roads as shown on the plat. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

139 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court ap proved Tax Cancellation Certificates # 33-39 with all members voting AYE.

140 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court unanimously approved accounts for the month of May 1975. Balance of accounts is as follows:
