

EQUALIZATION MEETING, JUNE 20, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court reconvened as a Board of Equalization on June 20, 1975 at 9:50 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon, Henry L. Grimes, Roy L. Holder, and James A. Speight present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

141 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court unanimously agreed to set the taxable value of property owned by Parmar L. Gregory of Greenville at \$1200.00.

142 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court approved a total taxable value of \$257,350.00 for the L & A Railway-Kansas City Southern line with that company's rolling stock valued at the Tax Office appraisal of Motion carried with all members present voting AYE.

143 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court unanimously agreed to approve a taxable value of \$136,000.00 for the Greenville Herald Banner.

There being no further business before the Board at this time, Judge Ed Terrell recessed the Hunt County Board of Equalization until further notice.
