## COMMISSIONER'S-COURT MINUTES July 17, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Special Session, Thursday July 17, 1975 at 1:30 P.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, with Commissioners Johnn/ie H. Lyon, Henry L. Grimes, and Roy L. Holder present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by County Judge Ed Terrell.

Mr. Short explained to the members of the Court the Off System Road Program that would make federal funds available to counties and to cities of under 5000 population, for the purpose of funding roads and bridges not on any federal aid system.

Mr. Joe Lytle, representing the Greenville Chamber of Commerce was present to inquire whether roads leading into the Industrial Park would be eligible for funding under this project.

The Court also discussed with the members of the Highway Department the proposed Farm to Market road between Clinton and Highway 66.
