

COMMISSIONER'S COURT MINUTES, SEPTEMBER 8, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session, Monday September 8, 1975 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, TEXAS with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Henry L. Grimes,

Minutes of the August 25, 1975 Regular Session were read and approved.

184 On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court voted to allow Harry Myers to lay a water line on the back slopes of the county road from the Mulberry Cove Road to Kitzie Ridge in Commissioner Precinct 2 with all members of the Court voting AYE.

185 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to approve the State Report on Delinquent and Insolvent Taxes, presented to the Court by Tax Assessor-Collector Harold Armstrong. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

186 On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court unanimously voted to accept with regret the resignation of Wes Reed as Assistant District Attorney, effective September 12, 1975.

187 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder, and seconded by James A. Speight, to appoint Tommy Bastian as Assistant District Attorney effective September 15, 1975 at the present salary of \$13,600 as funded by the Criminal Justice Council Grant. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

188 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court unanimously agreed to pass an order of removal of a gate across a county road in Commissioner Precinct 1, west of Highway 34 between Greenville and Wolfe City. The parties involved were notified action would be taken to remove the gate if it was not voluntarily removed. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

189 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court unanimously agreed to pass on consideration of rescinding an order to provide fees of \$5.00 for Justice of the Peace on Drivers License Hearings, until a later date in order to study the matter further.

190 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court unanimously approved accounts for the month of August, 1975. Balance of accounts is as follows:

Speight, the Court voted to authorize Judge Ed Terrell to sign a Contract Cancellation Notice to cancel the delinquent tax collection contract with Mays & Co., Tax Attorneys, dated January 13, 1975. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

There being no further business, Judge Ed Terrell adjourned the Court.
