

COMMISSIONER COURT MINUTES, SEPTEMBER 22, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session, Monday September 22, 1975 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas. Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon, Henry L. Grimes, Roy L. Holder, and James A. Speight were present with Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Mrs. Adelle Taylor.

Minutes of the September 8, 1975 Regular Session were read and approved.

**192** On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon the Court approved a request by Mrs. Marjorie Moore of the Welfare Department to allow Bob Parkhill and Randy Upton to attend a two day seminar on legal problems at a cost of \$66.00. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

**193** Motion was made by Henry L. Grimes and seconded by James A. Speight to approve the Public Weighers Bond of W. R. Wilson. Motion carried with all members present voting AYE.

**194** On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court unanimously approved the appointment and bond of Millard F. Glaze as Public Weigher to substitute for Mr. C. P. Holmes as County Weigher in Mr. Holmes absence.

**195** Motion was made by Johnnie H. Lyon and seconded by James A. Speight to agree to meet with the Greenville City Council on Monday, September 29, 1975 at 7:00 P.M. in the Citizens Room of the Citizens National Bank in

Greenville. The Purpose of the meeting is to discuss Fire and Ambulance Contracts with the City of Greenville. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

196 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the Court unanimously agreed to set Jury Fees at a rate of \$5.00 per day.

197 Motion was made by James A. Speight and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to approve the bond of Assistant District Attorney Tommy Bastian. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

198 Motion was made by James A. Speight and seconded by Henry L. Grimes to place County Attorney Administrative Assistant Donald Parks on the County payroll effective October 1, 1975, with Mr. Parks to be moved to the position of Assistant County Attorney at such time as he is licensed. Mr. Parks' salary was previously funded through the Manpower Program. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

199 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to place the Xerox machine in the County Clerk's Office and to adapt the machine to operate on the Autotron Key System. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

Motion was made by Roy L. Holder to ask the County Treasurer to operate the County's postage machine for an additional \$50.00 per month. Motion died for lack of second.

After further discussion it was agreed by the Court to withhold any action concerning the Xerox machines and postage machine pending further study.

200 On a motion by Judge Ed Terrell, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court voted to purchase two window unit air conditioners for the Courthouse, to be placed in the office of the Veterans Service Officer and the employees coffee room, with all members present voting AYE.

201 Motion was made by Johnnie H. Lyon and seconded by Henry L. Grimes to enter into a three month contract for fire fighting and ambulance services with the City of Greenville, being the same as the previous contract with the term of the contract to run from October 1, 1975 through December 31, 1975. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

202 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon, the court approved a request by the County Agent to reimburse the Post Office in the amount of \$17.50 for mailing fees on 4-H Club letters. All members of the Court voted AYE.

203 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder and seconded by James A. Speight to deny a request for travel expenses for Becky Odom of the County Agent's Office. Motion carried with all present voting AYE.

204 Judge Ed Terrell presented a new contract proposal from Pritchard & Abbott, Tax Appraisers, to the Court. The new proposal would mean an increase in fees paid by the County. Motion was made by James A. Speight and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to reject the proposed contract with Pritchard & Abbott. Motion carried with Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon, Henry L. Grimes, and James A. Speight voting AYE and Commissioner Roy L. Holder voting NO.

At 11:05 A.M. Judge Ed Terrell called a recess of the Court.

At 12:20 P.M. Judge Terrell reconvened the Regular Session of the Commissioner's Court to consider payroll changes in the Juvenile Detention Center as an emergency item.

205 Motion was made by James A. Speight and seconded by Henry L. Grimes to approve the following payroll changes in the Juvenile Detention Center: Frank Jones, Roger McLennan, Bill Yarbrough and Alemetta Sanders were removed from the payroll. Lana Barrett, Hernando Hernandez, Jr, Linda Mershawn, Savoy Young, Austin Stewart, Kathy Roberson and Michael Massey were added as Juvenile Probation Interns to work 10 hours each week without pay for credit at ETSU, and at \$2.00 per hour for each hour above 10 hours per week. Imogene Ewalt is added as relief worker at a standard rate of \$2.00 per hour. Motion to approve these changes carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

All business being considered, Judge Ed Terrell adjourned the Regular Session of the Court.
