

COMMISSIONER'S COURT MINUTES, OCTOBER 13, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session, Monday, October 13, 1975 at 9:00 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Roy L. Holder.

Minutes of the September 19 Public Hearing, September 22 Regular Session and September 22 Public Hearing were read and approved.

207 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court approved a request by Harold Armstrong, Tax Assessor-Collector, to authorize the building of wooden filing trays at an approximate cost of \$200.00 and additional work area in the Tax Office at an approximate cost of \$700.00. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

208 On a motion by Henry L. Grimes, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court unanimously agreed to move the County Veterans Day Holiday from October 27 to November 11 in accordance with the holiday as set by the State legislature.

209 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder and seconded by James A. Speight to approve for filing the plats of Waco Bay Estates Phase 3 and Phase 4 with the stipulation Hunt County Will not maintain any roads in Waco Bay. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

210 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court accepted a Criminal Justice Grant for the funding of the Assistant District Attorney and one secretary in the District Attorney's Office. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

211 Motion was made by James A. Speight and seconded by Roy L. Holder to correct Order # 17, Volume 27 Page 375 of the Commissioner's Court Minutes entering into an agreement to participate with the Manpower Services Program. The motion reads ".... The County is not obligated to provide insurance or retirement for the Title 6 employee or the Professional Service Employee...". The motion is amended to read "....The County is not obligated to provide insurance or retirement for the Title 6 employee. Hunt County will provide insurance and retirement for the Professional Service Employee..!" Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

212 Motion was made by Henry L. Grimes and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to close a road in the Union Hill area as notice of the closing has been posted the required length of time and no objections to the closing had been made. Motion to close the road carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

213 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court voted unanimously to take bids on three 1976 cars for the Sheriff's Department per specifications requested by the Sheriff. One car will be colored to be used as an investigators car and the other two will be white. Bids will be opened on November 3, 1975 at 10:00 A.M.

214 On a motion by Roy L. Holder, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court authorized the purchase of a calculator for the County Judge's Office on a Lease/Purchase plan. The calculator is presently being leased from Shelton Office Supply. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

215 Motion was made by Roy L. Holder and seconded by Johnnie H. Lyon to table consideration of purchasing an intercom for the County Court-at-Law. Motion carried with all present voting AYE.

214 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court voted to allow Precinct 1 to purchase a used truck chassis to be used with the bed of a wrecked dump truck. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

217 On a motion by James A. Speight, seconded by Henry L. Grimes, the Court voted to call a Special State Constitutional Election for November 4, 1975 and to rescind a previous order setting the polling hours from 8 :00 A.M. to 7:00 P .M . Polling hours will be from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P .M . Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

Motion was made by Roy L. Holder to declare the November 4th election day a holiday and close the Court-house . Motion died for lack of second.

Mr. Wall spoke to the Court concerning the Sabine River bridge in Commissioner Precinct 4.

Judge Terrell recessed the Court for 10 minutes to consider account for the month of September.

Court reconvened at 10:20 A.M . in the Commissioner's Courtroom with all members of the Court present.


