

COMMISSIONER'S COURT MINUTES, DECEMBER 1, 1975

The Hunt County Commissioner's Court met in Emergency Session, Monday, December 1, 1975 at 10:30 A.M. in the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Mr. Ben Green, father of Sheriff Wayne Green, was a visitor of the Court.

258 Sheriff Green told the Court of a prisoner being held in Baltimore, Maryland. Charges have been made against the prisoner in Hunt County, and the Sheriff asked the Court for authorization to bring the man to Hunt County. The cost of plane fare for the Sheriff and prisoner would be \$303.00. On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by James A. Speight, the Court voted to allow Sheriff Green to see if the prisoner could be put on a plane and sent back direct and if not, Sheriff Green is authorized to make arrangements to go to Baltimore to bring him back. Motion carried with all members of the Court voting AYE.

Donald Parks and Blake Hanson of the County Attorney's office presented to the the members of the Court a rough draft of Subdivision Regulations and Private Sewage Regulations.

There being no further business, Judge Ed Terrell adjourned the Meeting.
