

COMMISSIONERS COURT MINUTES, MAY 5, 1976

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Special Session, Wednesday, May 5, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon, Henry L. Grimes, and Roy L. Holder present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding. Commissioner James A. Speight was absent.

Invocation was given by Judge Terrell.

331 On a motion by Johnnie H. Lyon, seconded by Roy L. Holder, the Court approved a request by Tax Assessor Collector Harold Armstrong to allow the hiring of four temporary typists in the tax office for as long as necessary to complete the typing of cards on vehicles registered in Hunt County for the tax roll. Salaries for the typists will be \$2.30 per hour. Motion carried with Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon and Roy L. Holder voting AYE and Commissioner Henry L. Grimes voting NO.

There being no further business, Judge Ed Terrell adjourned the Court.
