

EQUALIZATION BOARD MINUTES, AUGUST 16, 1976

The Hunt County Board of Equalization reconvened August 16, 1976 at 9:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with Commissioners Johnnie H. Lyon, Henry L.
