NOVEMBER 12, 1976

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Special Session, Friday, November 12, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Court Room, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with Commissioners James A. Speight, Roy L. Holder, and Henry L. Grimes present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Judge Ed Terrell.

476 On a recommendation by Judge Ed Terrell, second by Commissioner James A. Speight, the court unanimously approved the following: Mrs. Bloom Johnson as Absentee Judge, Ellis R. Brigham as Voting Judge Precinct 2, Katie Johnson and Roy L. Wilson as Clerks for the Option Election to be held in Neylandville at the Fire Hall, December 4, 1976.

477 On a motion by James A. Speight, second by Commissioner Roy L. Holder, the court unanimously approved a canvassing board to canvas the absentee votes, composed of Raymond Dunn, Murray Rogers and Alton Jordan.
