

COMMISSIONERS COURT MINUTES

DECEMBER 13, 1976

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in regular session, Monday, December 13, 1976, at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas, with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by County Attorney Richard Carter.

Minutes of the November 22, 1976 regular meeting and the December 9, 1976 special session were approved as read.

488 On a motion by Commissioner Henry L. Grimes, second by Johnnie H. Lyon, the court unanimously approved the plat for Vincent Murphy's Wranglers Rest, stipulating that the county would not maintain the roads in the plat.

489 On a motion by Commissioner James L. Speight, second by Henry L. Grimes, the court unanimously voted to pay  $\frac{1}{2}$  the ambulance service fee for Tilford Collins requests by John Sealy Hospital.

490 On a motion by Commissioner Roy L. Holder, second by James L. Speight, the court unanimously approved the bid by Grady Chevrolet for Precinct 3 on two 1977 Chevrolet  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ton chassis-cabs, one at \$7386.00 less 1964 trade in of \$500.00, the second \$7386.00 less \$350.00 trade in for a total of \$13,922.00 and a 1977 Chevrolet  $\frac{1}{2}$  ton pickup less 1963 trade in for \$4401.00.

— Bids on the Reef repairs submitted by Wallace Hefner was passed until further study could be made.

491 On a request by Harold Armstrong, Tax Assessor Collector, new forms for tax roll approval were signed by the Commissioners Court. Austin has new computer forms and would not accept the old ones previously signed.

492 On a motion by Commissioner Roy L. Holder, second by James A. Speight, the fee schedule for sewer disposal facilities were passed. Commissioners Henry L. Grimes and Johnnie H. Lyon voted NO and Commissioners Roy L. Holder and James A. Speight voted AYE. Judge Ed Terrell voted AYE to break the tie.

— Passed consideration of Personnel matter by County Attorney.

493 On a motion by Commissioner Johnnie H. Lyon, second by Henry L. Grimes, the court unanimously approved a request for the advertising of bids on a new pickup for Precinct 1.

494 On a motion by Judge Ed Terrell, second by Henry L. Grimes, the court unanimously changed the dates for the Christmas Holidays from December 23, 24 to December 24 and 27, 1976.

495 On a motion by Commissioner James A. Speight, second by Roy L. Holder, the court unanimously approved the right of way request by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company.

496 On a motion by Commissioner Roy L. Holder, second by Henry L. Grimes, the court approved the request by Merrick Money for the auditor to purchase a new typewriter for the Justice of Peace Office.

497 On a motion by Commissioner James A. Speight, second by Henry L. Grimes, the court voted for the addressograph equipment to be transferred from the tax office to the county agents office. James Greer, assistant county agent, resigned effective December 31, 1976, so that he might attend Texas A & M to work on his Masters Degree.

— No action was taken on the presentation by Weldon Bestick and Harold Rucker from IBM, on a computer for the tax office.

498 On a motion by Commissioner Roy L. Holder, second by Johnnie H. Lyon, the court unanimously approved the removal of Wayne Jones from the payroll in Precinct 3, effective December 10, 1976.

499 On a motion by Commissioners James A. Speight, second by Roy L. Holder, the court voted unanimously for an expression of interest to be sent to John Anderson of N.T.C.O.G. regarding the County Personnel Project.

500 On a motion by Commissioner James A. Speight, second by Johnnie H. Lyon, the court unanimously approved the monthly accounts for November.
