## COMMISSIONERS COURT MINUTES

DECEMBER 23, 1976

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Special Session on Thursday, December 23, 1976, at 10:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Judge Terrell.

Purpose of the meeting was for discussion of proposals for Ambulance Service for Hunt County.

Views were presented from representatives of the City of Greenville, Lene Oak, Welfe City, Caddo Mills, Commerce, and other interested persons.

Judge Terrell presented the three fellowing prepesals to the Court:

- I: X No. Dellars budgeted by County for ambulance service. Population figures from NTCOC-177. A percentage to be paid or allocated to each incorporated town based on its population. Towns providing service to towns without ambulance service would receive that towns share.
- 2. County centinue to underwrite ambulance services lesses to towns or Funeral Homes providing ambulance service to rural areas.
- Grant permission for private ambulance service to serve the county on subscription basis.

503 Judge Terrell made a motion that the County adopt the No. 1 Proposal and allocate a total of \$30,000.00 to be based on the population percentage of each incorporated town, beginning on January 1, 1973, Motion was seconded by Commissioner Roy L. Helder and carried with Commissioners Henry L. Grimes, Roy L. Helder, and James A. Speight voting AYE and Commissioner Johnnie H. Lyen voting NO.

There being no further business the Court adjourned.
