

COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

March 22, 1982

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session March 22, 1982 at 10:00 A. M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present, except for Judge Ed Terrell. Commissioner Roy Holder presided in the absence of Judge Terrell.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Mike Crowell.

Minutes of the March 8, Regular Session, and the March 15, 1982 Special Called Meeting were approved as read.

**1602** Dove Hill Estates Final Plat was unanimously approved without the roads, until the roads are passed and approved. This was made on the Motion by Commissioner Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1603** Approval of County Roads, owned and maintained by the County was unanimously approved by a certification and recorded in the Deed Records. This was made on the Motion by Mike Crowell, second by Johnnie H. Lyon.

**1604** Chuck Clemons spoke on the request by the Adult Probation Department to withdraw from the County retirement. On the Motion by Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon, the Court unanimously approved that this request be tabled.

**1605** On the Motion by Mike Crowell, second by Johnnie Lyon, the Court unanimously approved for Box 6 A to be at Greenville Automatic Gas, instead of the Ardis Heights Baptist Church.


**1606** On the Motion by Commissioner Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes, the Court unanimously approved to resend the order # 1589 of the closing of Old Coppinger Road because of protest.

**1607** There were two Typewriter Contracts submitted. One from IBM for \$1247.00 a year, and the other one from Office Equipment Co. for \$1030.00 a Year. On the Motion by Commissioner Henry Grimes, second by Mike Crowell, the Court unanimously approved to except the low bid from Office Equipment.


**1608** Accounts for the first of March were unanimously approved on the Motion by Johnnie Lyon second by Mike Crowell.
