

COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

APRIL 26, 1982

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session Monday, April 26, 1982 at 10:00 A. M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas, with all members present, and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Henry Lee Grimes.

Minutes of the April 12, 1982 Regular Session were approved as read.

**1619** Charles Turner read a letter from County Attorney Fred Shelton, concerning the request from Eben Carsey on a \$20.00 Tax refund. The Court approved to refund Mr. Carsey \$20.00. This was made on the Motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes. Lyon, Grimes, and Crowell voted aye, and Commissioner Holder opposed.

**1620** On the Motion by Roy L. Holder, second by Johnnie H. Lyon the Court unanimously approved a Right Of Way request from Peoples Telephone Co. but denied blanket request.

**1621** The Court unanimously approved the Plat of Trails End Sub-division, and the plat on Indian Trails will be delayed. This was approved on the motion by Roy L. Holder, second by Mike Crowell.

**1622** Request from the two J P offices to send Court Clerks to School was unanimously denied on the motion by Roy L. Holder, second by Johnnie H. Lyon.

**1623** Request for Full time help in JP Gloria Peters office will be tabled. This was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1624** On the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell, the Court unanimously approved the corrections and cancellations on the Tax Roll.

**1625** Mr. Burl Satterwhite discussed a County Road in the Cash area, and the Court unanimously approved for Mr. Grimes to be allowed to restore the road to an all weather road. This was approved on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1626** On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Mike Crowell, the Court unanimously approved a Mini contract for maintance on the Savin machinewith Copy Products.

**1627** The Court unanimously approved the accounts for April, on the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes.

**1628** The Child Welfare Office had a request to borrow \$4000.00 from thier account until the State pays them, and was unanimously approved on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Roy Holder.

A letter of resignation from Paul Cornell was read by Judge Terrell.
