## COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session Monday, July 26, 1982 at 10:00 A. M. in the Commissioner Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present and Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Henry Lee Grimes.

Minutes of the July 12, 1982 Regular Meeting were approved as read.

Judge Terrell opened a bid from Trinity Equipment Co. for a used Motor Grader for \$ 16,500 with trade, that was unanimously approved on the Motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes.

- There were no Payroll changes.

1680 On the Motion by Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon, the Court unanimously approved two right of way request for Continental Telephone, and two for United Telephone Co.

1681 The July accounts were unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon.

A Road off Hwy.224, developed by Walter Remington in 1972 in the McGaughey Survey that has been maintained by the County since that time was unanimously accepted on the motion by Commissioner Johnnie Lyon, second by Mike Crowell.

There was a discussion by Mr. Wilson and Mr. Carroll with CME Builders concerning the building Construction Management of the Criminal Justice Center. No Action was taken at this time.

1683 The Court unanimously approved the Design Development Plan for the Criminal Justice Center and to go on to the next phase. This was approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell.
