

COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

OCTOBER 11, 1982

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session Monday October 11, 1982 at 10:00 A.M. in the Hunt County Courthouse, Commissioners Courtroom, Greenville, Texas with all present except Commissioner Johnnie Lyon, with Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Mike Crowell.

Minutes of the September 27, 1982 Regular Session were approved as read.

1717 A Bid from Bill Martin Equipment Co. for a Tigar Boom Mower for \$ 11,850.00 for Precinct 3, was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Henry Grimes.

1718 Judge Terrell opened bids from Harrison Pontiac for a ½ ton Pickup for \$ 9,085.31, and a 3/4 ton for \$ 10,585.38. A Bid from Williams Motors Co. , ½ ton for 8,809.91, and 3/4 ton for 10,359.22. The Court unanimously approved the low bid from Williams Motors for the two Pickups, on the motion by Mike Crowell, second by Roy Holder, for Precinct 4.

1719 There was a request from Star Cable TV Co. for a permit for a Right of Way in the Cash area and other areas. Roy Holder made the motion to approve, but motion died due to lack of being second.

1720 On the motion by Mike Crowell, second by Roy Holder the Court unanimously approved that payroll checks be issued on listed paydays with no exceptions except with the exception of the Christmas check, and that checks would be ready on listed paydays by 8:00 A. M.

1721 Bid specifications for insect and rodent control were unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell.

1722 Payroll change in Precinct 2, to remove John Cherry as of October 5, 1982, was unanimously approved on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Roy Holder.

1723 There was a Right of Way request from Continental Telephone Co. in Precinct 3, that was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell.

1724 A request from Bobby Young Sheriff, for authority to advertise for bids for four cars for the Sheriffs Office , 1982 or 1983 models, cash or with trade was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Henry Grimes. Bids will be opened November 8.

1725 There was a discussion concerning animal control on private property by Sam Stewart. The Court unanimously approved an agreement with Upper Sabine Soil Conservation on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Roy Holder.

1726 The Court unanimously approved for the County Auditor to issue a check for \$8.38 to Roger Yeager Ford Co. in Wolfe City for sales tax he paid the Tax Assessor Office. This was approved on the motion by Mike Crowell, second by Roy Holder.

— There was a Presentation by Jack Hart of Mays, Hart & Co., regarding Delinquent Tax Collecting Contracts. No action was taken at this time.

— No action was taken at this time on the Telephone System.

— The Commissioners Court will meet with the Fire Chiefs Association October 18, in Lone Oak.

— Road Inspections of Indian Trail and Cole Lane will be inspected by the Court.

1727 The new Election Judge and altonant for Box 35A is Gilbert and Helen Garrett, and was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Henry Grimes.

Court recessed until 2:00 P. M.

Court reconvened at 2:00 P. M. with public hearing on Proposed County Budget for 1982-83

1728 There was a motion by Henry Grimes, and second by Roy Holder to raise Judy Layman to R-3. Grimes and Holder voted aye, and Crowell and Judge Terrell opposed. Motion did not carry due to a tie.

1729 Concerning Bill Green drawing longevity pay, Commissioner Henry Grimes made a motion that he draw it, but died due to lack of being second.

1730 On a projected tax rate of 22 cents the 1982-83 proposed County Budget was adopted with the amended changes. No tax rate has been set but projected at 22 cents. This was approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell. Holder and Crowell voting aye, and Grimes opposed.

The accounts were unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell.
