

COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

DECEMBER 20, 1982

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session, Monday December 20, 1982 at 10:00 A. M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present with Judge Ed Terrell presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Mike Crowell.

Minutes of the December 13, 1982 Regular Meeting were approved as read.

1769 There was a payroll change in Precinct 3, to add Joe Parsons as mechanic effective January 1, 83. This was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon.

— There were no Right of Way request.

1770 On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Mike Crowell, the accounts were unanimously approved.

— The Court will go out and give the second inspection on a road on F. M. 2101 near E-Systems.

1771 There were bids taken Monday for the Criminal Justice Center for the Electrical, concrete, steel and mechanical work. Low bids were awarded to the following - American Steel Inc., CES Group Inc., Don Burden Assoc., West Construction Co., North Texas Co., Austin Steel, and VSL Co., bids are on file. This was approved on the motion by Mike Crowell, second by Roy Holder. Grimes opposed, and Lyon sustained. Judge Terrell cast his vote of aye.

1772 There was a change order unanimously approved on the jail project. The Court authorized Mr. Wiginton to make this change, on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell.

— No Action was taken at this time on the Preliminary Plat of Quinlan Place, with Mr. F. M. McArthur.

1773 The Court unanimously approved to discontinue sales of tin horns, culverts, and bridge materials to the public. This was approved on the motion by Mike Crowell, second by Roy Holder. Effective February 1, 1983

1774 The Court unanimously accepted the Cole Lane, that has been previously been inspected. This was approved on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon.
