

COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

JANUARY 10, 1983

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session Monday January 10, 1983 at 10:00 A. M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas, with all members present with Judge J. W. Bill Green presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Henry Lee Grimes.

Minutes of the December 29, 1982 Special Session Meeting were approved as read.

1779 On the motion by Henry Lee Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon, it was unanimously approved by the Court to keep both Insurance policies.

1780 There was a request for a permit application from Continental Telephone of Texas to place a buried communication cable South of Van Sickle Community Center. Construction will begin January 3, 1983. This request was unanimously approved on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon.

1781 On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes, The Court unanimously approved the County Officials, Bonds, and are recorded in Bond Record Book volume 8.

1782 There were two payroll changes unanimously approved by the Court on the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes. Louise Walker was added to the County Judge's office at 1020.00 a Month, and Judy Layman in the Commissioners office was raised to 1020.00 a Month, effective January 1, 1983.

1783 The Court unanimously approved to take applications for a Veterans Officer on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Henry Grimes.

1784 On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes the Court unanimously approved to advertise for bids on Bank Depository, and to open bids February 14, 1983.

1785 The Court unanimously approved and set the Holidays for 1983, which are April 1st., May 30th., July 4th., September 5, ^{November 11, &} November 24, & 25th. and December 23rd. and 26th. These were approved on the Motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Roy Holder, subject to change.

Court went into Executive Session.

Court went back into Regular Session.

1786 On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes the Court unanimously approved for the County to pay Miss Jewel Kelly for land acquired by the County and to pay Mr. Randy Tarpley his fees, total of \$5,190 less \$1,000 in deposit with Kincy Abstract Co. This will be deeded to the County.

Court went into executive Session


No Action was taken on the executive Session.
