

COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL EMERGENCY MEETING

MARCH 22, 1983

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in an Emergency Session Tuesday March 22, 1983 at 9:00 A. M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas, with all members present and Judge Green presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Johnnie Lyon.

Court went into Session regarding Payment Performance Bond from West Construction Co. on the New Criminal Justice Center.

Court recessed until 10:30.

Court reconvened at 10:30

1842 A Payment Performance Bond was required from West Construction Co., and Contractor said he would provide this Bond, but did not and started work, and now says he cannot provide Bond. Commissioners Court believes it is in the best interest of the taxpayers to keep this contractor on the job. This will avoid a time consuming period of resiting the job and save a considerable amount of money on the project. Under the circumstances the Court waived the Bond requirement and increased the contractors retainage to 15% and will issue dual joint checks where they elect, and that contractor must agree in writing with this agreement before any payment can be made. This Resolution was unanimously approved on the motion by Commissioner Roy Holder, second by Henry Grimes.
