

COMMISSIONERS COURT MEETING

MARCH 28, 1983

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session Monday March 28, 1983 at 10:00

A. M. in the Commissioners Courtroom, Hunt County Courthouse, Greenville, Texas with all members present and Judge J. W. Green presiding.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Roy Holder.

Minutes of the March 14, 83, Regular Session and March 22, 83, Emergency Meeting were approved as read.

**1843** Bid proposals will be re-advertised for the repairs to the Men's restrooms. This was unanimously approved on the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes.

Discussion of billing from Parkland Hospital was passed till a later date.

**1844** The Court unanimously approved to re-advertise for bids for corrugated galvanized pipe. This was approved on the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes.

**1845** Permission to re-advertise for bids for a new maintainer for Precinct 3, was unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1846** Adoption of Hunt County's employees Manual will be postponed until the next meeting and copies of the manual will be distributed to all Officials. This was unanimously approved on the motion by Johnnie Lyon second by Henry Grimes.

**1847** The request from the Coca Cola Co., to place a canned drink machine in the Courthouse was unanimously approved by the motion by Roy Holder, second by Mike Crowell. Price will be 40 cents a can. There will be no fee rent on machine, and Woody will service.

**1848** The Court unanimously approved to pay second quarter payment of \$ 28,337.43 to the Hunt County Tax Appraisal District. This was made on the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1849** On the Motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Roy Holder, the Court unanimously approved an exception to the Septic Tank Ordinance for the Merit Meat Market.

**1850** The Court unanimously approved for the County Judge to have the same travel expenses as Constables. This was approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Henry Grimes.

**1851** On the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon the Court unanimously approved to retro active travel expensed back to January for Judge Green.

No Action was taken with Western American Telephone Co.

**1852** The Court unanimously approved to reimburse Clark's Wheeled Sports Co. on a tax refund of \$2.50, on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1853** On the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Mike Crowell, the Court unanimously accepted under the old subdivision rules and regulations the final Plat of Shady Oaks, Subdivision, with the stipulation that the Court will inspect the roads.

**1854** There was a change order regarding Lathing and Plaster Contract, and the Court accepted the bid from North East Texas Tile Company and will add to existing contract. This was unanimously approved on the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Roy Holder.

Discussion of Fuel storage tank and metered pump for the Criminal Justice Center will be passed till a later date.

There were no payroll changes.

**1855** The accounts payable were unanimously approved on the motion by Roy Holder, second by Johnnie Lyon.

**1856** On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Roy Holder, the Court unanimously approved and adopted the prevailing Wage Scale as recommended by the Architect for the Hunt County Criminal Justice Center.
