

REGULAR SESSION
January 28, 1985

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom, with all members present and Judge Green presiding.

Judge Green delivered the invocation. Minutes of prior meetings were approved with noted correction.

OLD BUSINESS:

2481 Regarding County Liability Insurance, on the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Grimes, the ^{COURT} agreed to set aside the \$35,000 budgeted this year for liability insurance for a self-insurance fund until Steve Ramsey can find a company who will insure the County.

2482 On the motion by John Mizell, second by Mike Crowell, the Court approved the easement request of Star Cable T.V. in Pct. # 3, with the stipulation that the County has no responsibility for cable repairs if damaged while maintaining the County road.

2483 On the motion by Lyon, second by Grimes, the Court approved the preliminary plat on Green Meadow Estates Subdivision, Pct. # 1.

2484 On the motion by Mizell, second by Crowell, the Court approved the preliminary plat on the Dr. Morris Subdivision, Pct. # 3--Dr. John Morris.

2485 On the motion by Grimes, second by Lyon, the Court voted to hold up on the approval of Grande Verde Subdivision, Pct. # 2 plat (road inspection report), Obe Veldman, per his request. Inspection and approval to be set at a later date.

— Final plat approval on Lost Creek Estates, Pct. # 3, Maxine Hayes, will be under OLD Business next meeting.

2486 On the motion by Mizell, second by Grimes, the Court agreed to postpone approval for Countess Country Subdivision, Pct. # 3--D.M. Sawyer until a later date & after legal information can be obtained. This due to a possible legal suit involving Countess Country.

— Appointment of a new trustee to MH/MR Board to replace Henry Suche was placed under OLD BUSINESS for the next meeting.

2487 On the motion by Grimes, second by Mizell, the Court approved official liability bonds for JP Gloria Peters and Commissioner Johnnie Lyon.

— For the record, all noncompliance items in the January 18th letter from the Commission on Jail Standards have been corrected. Letter to that affect has been issued.

NEW BUSINESS:

2488 On the motion by Crowell, second by Grimes, the Court approved the preliminary plat on Triangle Acres, Pct. # 4, W. Homer Martin. Inc.

— Regarding fencing-off of County Road in Merit-Roy Blevins. For the record, the County Attorney has given Mr. Russell 15 days to remove the fence from the road.

2489 For the Record: Roads in the Valter Hale subdivision, Pct. # 2 have been accepted as County Roads. Motion by Grimes, second by Crowell. Unanimous vote.

— Regarding bridge in Whiskers # 3-Erlene Harris. Withdrawn from agenda.

2490 On the motion by Crowell, second by Mizell, the Court accepted the resignation of Justice of the Peace C.J. Walden, effective March 31, 1985.

2491 On the motion by Crowell, second by Mizell, the Court appointed Harry G. Champion to fill out the term in JP Pct. 2 created by the resignation of C.J. Walden.

2492 On the motion by Grimes, second by Crowell, the Court agreed to TDC refinishing all the oak chairs (straight, swivel, and arm) in the Courthouse.

2493 On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Accounts Payable were approved.

Sheriff Dept.: Add Jason Cunningham, Deputy (R-9), effective 1-19-85; Carol Zboza, Jailer (R-2), effective 1-15-85. Move Sherry Pruitt to Chief Dispatcher (R-3) effective 1-1-85. Also, add: Theresa Clark, Matron Jailer, effective 1-24-85; Robert Pierce, Deputy, effective 1-24-85.

Tax Office: Remove Lea Rickman, R-2, effective 2-1-85. Add Sandra G. Myers, R-1 effective 2-1-85; Move Glenda Kirkman from R-1 to R-2 effective 2-1-85.

2494 Motion by Henry Grimes, second by Mike Crowell. Unanimous vote.

2495 On the motion by Grimes, second by Mizell, the Court approved the relocation of the following County Offices: County Judge to Drivers License (2nd Flr.); Drivers License to the JPs offices vacated on the 1st floor; The Agricultural Ext. Office from the 4th floor to the vacated Sheriff's Offices on the 1st floor; Adult Probation to the Ag. Offices; The Law Library to be housed in the area vacated by the Adult Probation on the 3rd floor.
