- Request regarding unmarked vehicles-Bobby Young: OLD BUSINESS next meeting.
- 2676 Request for easement from Continental Telephone, Pct #2 (Tank Farm) was approved on the motion by Grimes, second by Crowell.

2677 Request for preliminary plat approval on Floyd Ranchettes, Phase II, Pct. #2-W.F.
