## REGULAR SESSION JUNE 23, 1986

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Court-room with all members present & Judge Green presiding. The Judge gave the invocation. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

## OLD BUSINESS:

- 2944 On the motion by John Mizell, second by Johnnie Lyon, the Court approved the installation of antique lights on the Courthouse square with the electricity to be tied into the County's useage system. The Co. Atty is to prepare the agreement regarding the light system. Dedication ceremony to be set for September 13, 1986.
- 2945 On the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Lyon, the Court unanimously approved the first road inspection in Buena Vista Estates, Pct. 2-- The inspection revealed all seal-coated roads. Co. Judge's Office to notify developer of approval.

## NEW BUSINESS:

- The Court heard from Don Parks & Marjorie Moore regarding the budget for the Child Welfare Dept. No action was required today.
- The Court opened bids on the auto for the Sheriff's Dept. Bids were: Greenville Chrysler-Plymouth, \$10,844.43; and Barker Ford, \$12,844.13. On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Court agreed to defer action until the next regular meeting.
- 294 On the motion by Grimes, second by Mike Crowell, the Court approved the proposed amendments to the Hoyle Addition restrictions. Judge Green to sign the amendments.
- The Court heard from W.N. Wilson regarding a county road in Pct. 3--No action taken. - The Court publicly noted that an easement was granted by Vernon Bench Jr. in Pct. #3. (See Co. Clerk file #7099)
- 2948 On the motion by Crowell, second by Lyon, the Court set July 14, 1986 at 10:00 am as an item on the regular agenda for the Public Hearing on Federal Revenue Sharing.
- 2949 On the motion by Crowell, second by Grimes, the Court unanimously approved for Pct. 4 to sell excess equipment at public auction. Any of the other Pcts. were also authorized to join in on the auction. Auction to be held at the South Company in Dallas. Proper notification will be made in the local newspapers.
- No Court members had any interest in a H.C. Shopper ad regarding the Fourth of July.
- 2950 On the motion by Lyon, second by Grimes, the Court gave Continental Telephone Co. permission to locate telephone line on a County road in Pct. 1 (Agreement in Co. Clerks Office)
- On the motion by Grimes, second by Lyon, the Court agreed to hold up such action in Pct. 2 until clarification of which road is to be included in the easement.
  - The Court considered recommendations from insurance Comp. regarding accident reports & driver's records. Court agreed that Dept. Heads should get driver's license numbers & names to be given to Insurance Comp.
- On the motion by Lyon, second by Crowell, the Accounts Payable were approved.
