

SEPTEMBER 8, 1986

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present & Judge Green presiding. Opening prayer was given by Mike Crowell. Minutes of the previous meetings were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS:

— Renewal of the Juvenile Probation Commission State Aid Agreement was dropped from the agenda.

3007 On the motion by Henry Grimes, second by Crowell, the Court authorized the Auditor to issue a check for the purchase of a lot in Old Town Quinlan (Lot 1, Blk. 4). The amount is \$4,000 plus \$140 for the title policy & other incidentals. Unanimous Vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

3008 On the motion by John Mizell, second by Crowell, the Court approved the final plat request on Old Mill Estates, Bob Adams. One change was made from the preliminary plat.

3009 On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Grimes, the Court approved the request from Continental Telephone of TX. to locate line on a county road in Pct# 1.

3010 On the motion by Mizell, second by Grimes, the Court authorized the Auditor to advertise for bids on a new pickup truck for Pct# 3. The bids are to include with & without trade-in.

3011 During a recess, the Court made the first road inspection in High Hollows II (FM 36). On the motion by Mizell, second by Grimes, the Court gave approval to the preliminary inspection.

— The mylar copy on the final plat of Buena Vista Estates in Pct# 2 was signed by the County Judge.

— Drop from the agenda "National Energy Security & Conservation Policy"

3012 Judge Green read a petition from residents of the Oasis Addition, Farmers Electric Coop & Cash Water Supply Co. seeking to get the Oasis Addition Community Road as a class two county road. On the motion by Mizell, second by Lyon, the Court accepted the petition for the record, and if the Court desires, will turn the matter over to the County Attorney for legal counsel. Unanimous Vote.

3013 On the motion by Crowell, second by Lyon, the Court accepted the contract with the City of Commerce concerning the Health Dept. Unanimous Vote.

3014 The Court received a letter from the State Highways & Public Transportation System regarding a program for posting signs at bridges. On the motion by Mizell, second by Grimes, the Court voted to participate in the program, and authorized the Co. Judge to notify the State Highway Dept.

3015 The Court received one proposal for computer consultants. It was from L.E. Mullen Co. in Tyler, TX. On the motion by Crowell, second by Grimes, the Court unanimously agreed to reject the proposal.

— Discussion of hospitalization insurance resulted in the Court seeking to receive an opinion from the Co. Attorney on contractual matters. There was no action taken today.

3016 On the motion by Grimes, second by Lyon, the accounts payable were approved.

District Court--Add Brenda Tanton, Court Coordinator, R-13, eff. 9/8/86.

3017 Approved on the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell.

The Court conducted a Public Hearing at 2 p.m. for the County Budget. After lengthy discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Lyon to adopt the budget as presented with no provision for an investigator in the County Attorney's Office, and those changes as made in the Health Dept. and District Attorney's Office. The motion died for lack of second.

3018 A motion was then made by Grimes, second by Crowell, to adopt the budget with the funds to be used for road signs dropped & part of that money to fund an investigator in the

County Attorney's Office with the balance of the funds going into the Contingency Acct.

For: Crowell, Mizell, Grimes. Opposed: Lyon
