

REGULAR SESSION
November 10, 1986

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom. Judge Green presided. Commissioner Mike Crowell was absent. Opening Prayer was given by John Mizell. Minutes of the previous meetings were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS:

- **3064** The Court heard from Dr. Kevin Bucher with the Family Services Center regarding an MH/MR Center for Hunt County. On the motion by Mizell, second by Johnnie Lyon, the Court requested that Dr. Bucher prepare an initial proposal for presentation to the Court and be authorized to coordinate with the Co. Attorney in the preparation of the proposal.

— Regarding the appointment of one member to the Child Welfare Board: OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

— Item #3--'Lawsuit styled C.W. Thomas & Ward Thomas, Jr. vs Hunt County Commissioners Court & Hopewell Water Supply: Drop from the agenda until hearing further from the Co. Attorney.

NEW BUSINESS:

— The Court received the report of 1985-86 tax collections from Joyce Barrow.

— Request for preliminary plat approval on "FM 1566 Estates", Pct #4-Bob Quinn & Mason Fritz: OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

— Drop from the agenda: 'Concerning a dirt road in Pct #2-Debra Snyder.'

- 3065** The Court heard from Mrs. Scottie Burnett & others about a dispute over who is entitled to ~~the~~ receive the County funds for the Quinlan Senior Citizens. On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Court voted to hold up the distribution of any funds to the Quinlan Senior Citizens until a solution to the problem can be worked out. For the motion: Lyon, Mizell, Judge Green /Opposed: Grimes. Motion Carries.

- 3066** On the motion by Mizell, second by Lyon, the Court accepted the low bid of Burnett Pest Control for insect & rodent control for the Courthouse-Bid price \$850 per year.

- 3067** On the motion by Grimes, second by Lyon, the Court accepted the low bid of McKenzie Asphalt Co. for paving of the County-owned parking lots-Bid price \$22,185.

- 3068** On the motion by Mizell, second by Grimes, the Court unanimously endorsed the resolution of the Quinlan Ind. School Dist. Trustees. Each addressee on the resolution to be notified of the Court's endorsement.

The Court then recessed for lunch. When the Court returned, Commissioner Grimes was absent.

Unless noted, unanimous votes by the Court include an aye vote by Judge Green.

3069 On the motion by Mizell, second by Lyon, the Court established the following policy regarding smoking: "Smoking will be limited to the general hallways of the Courthouse & the employees' breakroom as well as those specific areas as designated by Dept. Heads within their departments. Unanimous Vote.

—— Item #8--'Request received for first road inspection in Creekside Estates, Pct.2-
OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

—— Item #9--'Consider request from Chief Powers for County to pay for prisoners
blood tests'-OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

—— Item #10--'Consider additional telephones for the Courthouse-OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

3070 Judge Green read the opinion from the Co. Atty regarding fees paid to the Justices of the Peace. On the motion by Lyon, second by Judge Green, the Court voted unanimously to no longer pay the JPs a fee for drivers license hearings & inquests.

—— Judge Green read a letter to the Court from the MKT Dallas subdivision about
abandonment of railroad line. No action necessary by the Court.

3071 On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Court unanimously approved the request from Continental Telephone Co. of TX. to locate lines on those specified Co. roads in Pct. 1&2.

—— For the record: Cathy Painter successfully completed the study course in Court Co-ordination as prescribed by the TX Center for the Judiciary, Inc. Board of Directors.


3072 On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Accounts Payable were approved.

3074 On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Court approved the canvass of the votes from the Nov. 4th General Election, with noted corrections.
