The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present and Judge Farris presiding. The purpose of the session was to consider future needs for Hunt County concerning construction of new farm-to-market roads or the upgrading of existing FM roads. The Highway Dept. needed this information by March 3rd.

3 159 On the motion by Henry Hensley, second by John Mizell, the Court set as the number one priority the upgrading of Hwy 35, between Hwy. 34-S and FM 751 (appx. 1.2 miles) to a 5-lane highway--including curb and guttering.

On the motion by Mizell, second by Hensley, the Court set as the number two priority the upgrading of FM 751 between Hwy 35-S to the Hunt County line (appx. 4 miles).
