MARCH 2, 1987


The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present and Judge Farris presiding. The purpose of the session was to consider future needs for Hunt County concerning construction of new farm-to-market roads or the upgrading of existing FM roads. The Highway Dept. needed this information by March 3rd.


3159 On the motion by Henry Hensley, second by John Mizell, the Court set as the number one priority the upgrading of Hwy 35, between Hwy. 34-S and FM 751 (appx. 1.2 miles) to a 5-lane highway--including curb and guttering.

3160 On the motion by Mizell, second by Hensley, the Court set as the number two priority the upgrading of FM 751 between Hwy 35-S to the Hunt County line (appx. 4 miles).
