The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioner's Courtroom with all members present & Judge Farris presiding. Opening Prayer was given by Jimmy Hamilton. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS:

—— 'Discuss setting policy regarding present employees of Hunt Co. who owe delinquent ad valorem taxes prior to 11-26-84'--under advisement by the County Attorney.

—— 'Consider payment to the State of Texas for outstanding motor vehicle fees'--under advisement by the County Attorney.

NEW BUSINESS:

Action on bids:

3171 (1) on the motion by Henry Hensley, second by Allen Martin, the Court took the low bid from Cann Typewriter Comp. of Quinlan, TX. for maintenance of typewriters @ \$40 per mach.

3172 (2) On the motion by John Mizell, second by Hensley, the Court accepted the sole bid on maintenance of air conditioning units at the Criminal Justice Center from Ken Parker Service @ \$1765 per year to be made in quarterly payments.

—— Judge Farris read a letter from the TX. Justice Court Training Center advising the Court that JP Merrick Money has successfully completed a 20 hr. course in the duties of his office.

—— No action was taken today regarding improvements to the Co. Attorney's Office. The Co. Auditor will review bids taken by the Co. Atty & the Court will consider line-item transfers.
