

Regular Session
December 28, 1987

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present & Judge Mike Farris presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved with a noted addition to Order # 3428.

OLD BUSINESS:

—— Consider approval of revised plat on Martin's Second Addition- Pct.2 (Milton Babb,Jr.): OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

—— Consider taking action on copier machine bids for County Clerk's Office: OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

—— The Court heard from Joyce Barrow who presented a plan for sub-stations in Quinlan & Commerce for the purpose of registration of vehicles. The Court agreed to hear more on the plan at the next meeting and possibly take action.

—— Judge Farris presented a plaque of appreciation to Mr. Bill Cunningham for his service on the Hunt Co. Tax Appraisal Dist. Board of Directors.

3444 On the motion by Mizell, second by Martin, the Court ordered the local option election for the City of West Tawakoni to be held on January 23, 1988.

3445 On the motion by Farris, second by Lyon, the Court appointed the following people to a two-year term on the Hunt County Family Services Center Board of Directors: Mr. Oliver Kirby, Mr. F. Duncan Thomas, Dr. Perry Smith, Dr. Paul Zelhart, Rev. Earnest Walt.

—— The Court heard from Duncan Thomas requesting additional office space. The Court took no action at the present time.

3446 On the motion by Martin, second by Hensley, the Court approved the request from Farmers Electric Cooperative, Inc. for permission to locate a line on a public roadway in Pct.4.

3447 On the motion by Mizell, second by Martin, the Court approved the preliminary plat on Kaden's Place- Pct.3 provided the County Health Officer has no objection.

3448 On the motion by Martin, second by Hensley, the Court authorized the Auditor to advertise for bids on the following for Pct.4:

- (1) Belly Dump Rock Trailer
- (2) new Backhoe
- (3) new Dump Bed
- (4) new Motor Grader

3449 On the motion by Hensley, second by Mizell, the Court amended the General Fund budget by transferring \$308.61 from Contingency to Highway Patrol Office - Payroll.

3450 On the motion by Mizell, second by Lyon, the Court authorized the Auditor to advertise for bids on steel for bridges.

3451 On the motion by Martin, second by Lyon, the Court approved the purchase of two radios for the Baliffs, at the request of Judge Paul Banner, provided the funds are available in the District Judge's budget. Purchase price \$650 each.

3452 The Court heard sworn testimony from Mr. John C. Barron & Mr. Terry Clark Treadway concerning a road located south of FM 1903, approx. ½ mile east of Van Sickle School. After hearing the testimony & receiving a petition from 13 people, the Court found that the road in question has not been abandoned for 20 years. The Court directed the County Attorney to notify Mr. Elmer McMillan that the fence crossing the road be removed.

3453 On the motion by Lyon, second by Hensley, the Accounts payable were approved.

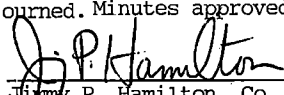
District Clerk: Remove Lou Ann Stewart, eff. 12-15-87. Add Christi Reeves, R-2 eff. 12-16-87.
