

SPECIAL SESSION  
January 29, 1988

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 1:30 pm in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present & Judge Farris presiding.


— The Court heard from Mr. J. Harris Morgan attorney for the Hunt County Tax Appraisal District. Mr. Morgan explained the necessity for the Court to ratify the action of the H.C.T.A.D. Board of Directors in purchasing and constructing the building now in use by the District. Mr. Joe Davis, Chief Appraiser for the District, gave sworn testimony that there are no liens against the property or pending litigation surrounding the construction of the building.

**3474** Following Davis' testimony, on the motion by Judge Farris, second by Henry Hensley, the Court ratified the action of the Board of Directors of the Hunt County Appraisal District in purchasing property and constructing a building in which to house the appraisal offices of said Appraisal District. Unanimous Vote.

**3475** On the motion by Allen Martin, second by John Mizell, the Court authorized the County Judge to sign a resolution regarding the preceding action taken by the Court.

**3476** On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, the Court agreed to pay the invoice from H & R Industries, Campbell, Tx. totalling \$19,912.00 for the 2400 poles to be used for the county road signs. Minutes approved this 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1988.
