

Special Session  
March 21, 1988

The Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present and Judge Mike Farris presiding. Two items were considered.

**3519** On the motion by Mizell, second by Hensley, the Court approved a resolution required by the State of Texas designating the Sheriff to sign for license plates to be used by County law enforcement officers on unmarked vehicles.

The Court heard from Mr. Gary Gunter with Contel Telephone Co. Mr. Gunter briefed the Court on Contel's proposed project which calls for the installation of fiber optic cable running from Cash to FM 1903, then west to Caddo Mills, then north on Highway 36 to Merit, then west to the county line. The project would begin around May 1, 1988.

**3520** On the motion by Hensley, second by Mizell, the Court unanimously agreed to waive the existing rules pertaining to the installation of utilities on or along the public roads effected by this project, pending proper wording of the agreement by the County Attorney.
