

REGULAR SESSION
May 9, 1988

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am in the Commissioners Courtroom with all members present & Judge Mike Farris presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

3549 The Court held a public hearing to consider adopting new rules to replace the existing ones in the use of private sewage facilities in Hunt County. After hearing from Jay Caudle and several residents, on the motion by Henry Hensley and second by Allen Martin, the Court tabled the item.

OLD BUSINESS:

— Consider request regarding Hunt County Fair Parade-Charles Austin: OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

— Consider adoption of mandatory physical examination for all new employees:

NEW BUSINESS:

3550 On the motion by Martin, second by John Mizell, the Court passed a resolution declaring May as National Health Month.

3551 On the motion by Mizell, second by Martin, the following people were appointed as members to the MH/MR Public Responsibility Committee: Walter Light, Gloria Peters, Roy Childs, John Sutton, June Henrickson, Betty Burns, Ruth Smith, and Carol Ferguson.

3552 On the motion by Hensley, second by Mizell, the Court accepted a check from Dr. Kevin Bucher in the amount of \$18,075.75--this check represents the remaining assests from North Central Texas MH/MR. The motion calls for the amount to be dedicated to the Hunt County Family Services Center.

— The Court took no action regarding a resolution in support of the Appraisal District proposal to institute a mapping program & to allocate the cost thereof.

The opening of bids resulted in the following action:

— (1) Steel Culverts--action to be taken under OLDBUSINESS at the next meeting.

— (2) hot & cold asphalt mix--no bids were received.

3553 (3) On the Motion by Hensley, second by Johnnie Lyon, the Court accepted the bid from Bryan & Bryan Asphalt Company of Henderson TX. for road oil at \$26.35 per barrel.

3554 A motion was made by Hensley, second by Mizell, to re-measure county roads per precinct for budget allocation purposes.

3555 On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, the Court authorized the Auditor to advertise for the purchase of a 10 yd. belly dump trailer in Precinct #2.

3556 On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, the Court authorized the Auditor to advertise for proposals on optical scan voting equipment.

3557 On the motion by Lyon, second by Hensley, the accounts payable were approved.

196th District Court-Remove Laura Taylor as Court Reporter and add Wm. W. Perkins, eff. 4-25-88.

Sheriff's Dept.-Add Jack Schultz, eff. 5-1-88, \$1,473 per month, (\$50) per month for six months. Remove Kenneth Robnett effective 5-1-88.

3558 Approved on the motion by Martin, second by Hensley.

3559 On the motion by Mizell, second by Martin, the Court approved the preliminary plat on Tri-Vet section II, Precinct #3--D.M. Sawyers.
