

Regular Session
May 23, 1988

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day in the Commissioners Courtroom at 10:00 am with all members present except for John Mizell. Judge Mike Farris presided. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS:

3561 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Henry Hensley, the Court authorized Judge Farris to work with Charles Austin on an award to be given each year at the Hunt County Fair Parade.

— Judge Farris told the Court that the information he had requested from TAC related to the item 'Consider adoption of mandatory physical examination for all new employees' had not been received and will put the item under OLD BUSINESS for the next meeting.

3562 On the motion by Martin, second by Hensley, the Court accepted the bid from Barnhardt's Steel Company for steel culverts & metal sheets.

NEW BUSINESS:

— The Court presented a plaque of appreciation to Dr. Kevin Bucher, outgoing Executive Director of the Hunt County Family Services Center.

3563 On the motion by Judge Farris, second by Martin, the Court adopted the Countywide Food Service Ordinance proposed by the Health Dept. and presented by Richard Briley.

For: Farris, Martin, Hensley. Against: Lyon. Motion Carries

3564 The Court then considered fees and licensing procedures for the Countywide Food Service Ordinance. On the motion by Martin, second by Lyon, the Court unanimously agreed to table action until its next meeting.

— The Court received a presentation from Mr. Jon Charles with the Boys & Girls Club of Hunt County.

— 'Consideration of compliance with specifications by bidder after award of road oil contract, and possible execution of road oil contract'. OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

3565 On the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon, the Court approved the request from Farmers Electric Cooperative, Inc. to locate line on public roadways in Pct. #2 - as shown on the maps attached to the requests.

— For the record: County Treasurer, Allie Cole Pearce, has completed a 20 hour seminar for County Treasurers at the V.G. Young Institute of County Government at Texas A & M.

3566 On the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon, the line item budget transfers were approved.

3567 On the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon, the accounts payable were approved.

The following action was taken under personnel & payroll changes:

3568 On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, add Mr. W.D. "Willie" Ballard as assistant district attorney, eff. 5-16-88.

3569 On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, the Court amended section 9, of ordinance #3560, by adding the following:

"thereafter all new covered business shall make application within 30 days of their moving into the County"
