

Regular Session  
September 12, 1988

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00 am with all members present and Judge Mike Farris presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS:

**3681** On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, the Court waived the 1987 amount of Hunt County's penalty & interest for Mr. Tommy Evans on Lot 81B located in the Last Frontier subdivision, Pct.2, due to an error in change of ownership made by the Appraisal District. Evans reported the change during the specified time period.

NEW BUSINESS:

— A motion was made by Hensley to renew the contract between the City of Greenville & Hunt County with the Texas Dept. of Health. Motion died for lack of second.

**3682** On the motion by Lyon, second by Martin, the Court agreed to renew the contract between the City of Greenville & Hunt County with the Texas Dept. of Health subject to County Attorney approval.

Unanimous Vote.

**3683** On the motion by Lyon, second by Hensley, the Court gave a waiver on the septic tank regulations for Ken Bowers in Pct.1 as recommended by Jay Caudle.

**3684** On the motion by Hensley, second by Martin, the Court approved the conceptual drawing of Cross Creek Subdivision, Pct.2. A preliminary plat will be considered at a later date.

**3685** On the motion by Mizell, second by Hensley, the Court approved the request from Tawakoni Water Utility Corporation to locate line on public roadways in Pct.3 with the "no Hunt County liability" disclaimer added. Also the corporation is to place the lines under roads and not cut the roads.

**3686** On the motion by Lyon, second by Martin, the Court approved a resolution regarding the sale of surplus right-of-way located in Pct.1.

— A motion was made by Judge Farris to sign the Bridge Load Posting Agreement with the State Dept. of Highways and Public Transportation. Motion died for lack of a second.

**3687** A motion was made by Lyon, second by Martin, to consider the <sup>Agreement</sup> ~~item~~ under OLD BUSINESS at the next meeting. Motion approved.

**3688** On the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon, the Court approved with a "no Hunt County liability" disclaimer, the request from Southwestern Bell Telephone Co. to locate line on public roadways in Pct.2 as presented on the maps attached to the request.

**3689** On the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon, the Court unanimously agreed to disapprove the notification of telephone construction received from Contel of Texas, Pct.2. The Court will notify the company of the action, stating the reasons for the disapproval.

— 'Consider funding for renovation of 3rd floor of Courthouse: OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

**3690** On the motion by Lyon, second by Martin, the Court rescinded order # 3678, passed 9-8-88, minutes approved 9-12-88.

**3691** On the motion by Lyon, second by Mizell, the Court approved a resolution regarding District Judges' supplement pay.

**3692** On the motion by Mizell, second by Martin, the Court authorized the County Auditor to advertise for one new pick-up truck, Pct.3.

The Court opened the bids on:

- (1) New pick-up truck, Pct.1
- (2) New or used Back-Hoe, Pct.1
- (3) New or used rubber tire excavator, Pct.1
- (4) Rocks & hauling for all precincts
- (5) Flex base road material for all precincts

—— The Court will take action on the above under OLD BUSINESS at the next meeting.

—— The Court received five proposals for Medical & Life Insurance for FY 88-89. The Court will study the proposals & take action under OLD BUSINESS at the next meeting.

—— The Court received one proposal for repair of the jail door openers at the Criminal Justice Center. The proposal was from Adtec, Inc. at \$59,160. The Court will take action under OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

**3693** On the motion by Martin, second by Mizell, the Accounts Payable were approved.

Personnel & Payroll Changes:

Pct.1- Add Haskell Henslee, part-time, \$7.25 per hr.

Pct.2- Move Horace Payne from R-5 to R-7, eff. 9-1-88. Remove Johnny Hillburn, eff. 8-30-88.

Dist. Atty- Remove Royal Mullins, eff. 8-31-88.

The Court received an order from the District Court Judges that the salary for District Court Reporters is fixed at \$27,937.00 eff. 10-1-88.

**3694** Approved on the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon. FOR: Hensley, Lyon, Martin, Mizell.

AGAINST: Judge Farris. Motion Carries.

**3695** On the motion by Hensley, second by Lyon, the Court approved the final road inspection for Hidden Oaks, Phase III, Pct.2 subject to actual inspection by the Court.

**3696** On the motion by Lyon, second by Hensley, the Court approved the Hickory Creek Water System request, with a "no Hunt County liability" disclaimer, to locate line on public roadway in Pct.1 with the stipulation that the line be buried at least 36" deep.
