5207 On the motion by Johnnie Lyon, second by Henry Hensley, the Court canvassed and approved the results of the June 5, 1993 Special Run-off Election.

5268 On the motion by Hensley, second by Allen Martin, the Court changed the Independence Day holiday from Friday, July 2nd to Monday, July 5th.

*5209 On the motion by Lyon, second by Judge Farris, the Court adopted a policy for the use of the JP Courtroom (also known as the Community Room) at the Criminal Justice Center. The policy calls for the two Justices of the Peace in Precinct 1 to oversee the scheduling of the room and that the use of the room to be restricted to government and legal functions. Organizations who have already paid for the use of the room for 1993 will be allowed to do so.
