

Regular Session  
May 27, 1997

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as changed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 6556** On the motion by Jim Walker, second by Allen Martin, the Court accepted bid from Southwest International Trucks in McKinney, Texas for 2-1996 New Truck Tractor 9200 for the net sales price of \$58,000 with trade-in value as submitted. \*\*See correction on page 236\*\*
- 6557** On the motion by Martin, second by Ralph Green, the Court approved the quarterly investment report for 1-1-97 thru 3-31-97 as presented by County Treasurer-Louise Walker. Report has been audited by our County Auditor-Jimmy Hamilton.
- 6558** On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved use of grant funding in the amount of \$22,441.82 from COG to upgrade computer hardware and to purchase a laptop computer for road work for Hunt Countys 911 project.
- 6559** On the motion by Martin, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved bid on resale property R70093, subject to acceptance by other involved taxing jurisdictions, struck off to the City of Commerce-located at 1606 Pecan. Property to be used by the Fire Department.
- 6560** On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved revised contract for assessment and collection service interlocal governmental between Hunt County and other taxing jurisdictions with effective date of 10-1-97, allowing 0.976 cents per parcel count.

HEAR & DISCUSS REPORTS:

Commissioner Thornton stated to the Court his committee on Chaparral Rails to Trails project has had two meetings discussing the long term effect of this project on Hunt County.

Hunt County Sheriff-Don Anderson and County Auditor-Jimmy Hamilton discussed with the Court needed line-item budget transfer of \$30,000 to pay for additional food supplies due to over crowding, group medical and mortuary services which are also over budget.
