

Regular Session
August 11, 1997

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

6625 Correction: On the motion by Kenneth Thornton, second by Martin, the Court corrected #6225 of the Commissioners Court records dated April 22, 1997 to read "the Court approved bids on seal coating from Ergon CRS-1P."

OLD BUSINESS:

6626 On the motion by Jim Walker, second by Ralph Green, the Court approved on the first part (Special Use Permit: Mobile Homes) of recommended changes to the Lake Tawakoni Planning Commissions Zoning Ordinance. On the motion by Walker, second by Martin, the Court approved on the second part (Zoning Districts) variances on zoning changes after report was given to the Court by Don Retzlaff.

NEW BUSINESS:

6627 Presentation of Quarterly Investment Report for review and acceptance was given to the Court by County Treasurer-Louise Walker. On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Alan Martin, the Court accepted report on unanimous vote.

6628 On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court denied request by property owner Gay Dehoff to change street name 'Haley Court' back to 'Monte Trail' in the Buena Vista Subdivision. The Court advised Ms. Dehoff too many changes would have to be made in the computer system, 911 data base and dispatch, local post office, regional post office, volunteer fire depts., central ambulance dept. and the telephone company.

6629 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court denied request for approval of final plat for Harper Estates located on FM1903 which will have aerobic water systems. The Court agreed not to approve 1½ acre tracts in Hunt County. Plat to be re-submitted to Court in 30 days.

_____ 'Presentation of AFLAC Cafeteria Plan:' Rich Reneau was not present; Larry Feille with National Family Care was present in Court-the Court agreed to place on OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

6630 On the motion by Kenneth Thornton, second by Martin, the Court approved request to advertise for sale of motorgraders-all precincts.

6631 On the motion by Thornton, second by Martin, the Court approved request to bury telephone cable along R-O-W of CR 1121 in Pct 1 with usual stipulations.

6632 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved request to bury telephone cable along R-O-W of CR 2316 and 2620 in Pct 2 with usual stipulations.

6633 On the motion by Walker, second by Martin, the Court approved request to bury telephone cable along R-O-W of CR 3675, 3605 and telegraph road in Pct 3 with usual stipulations.

6634 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Martin, the Court approved application and resolution for Hunt County to participate in the General Services Commissions Cooperative Purchasing Program which would authorize the County to purchase anything on pre-approved list by the State without having to go out for bids. Judge Bobbitt appointed as agent to participate in program.

6635 On the motion by Martin, second by Thornton, the Court approved canvass of the August 9th, 1997 Special Constitution Amendment Election: For 3,244 and against 168.

_____ 'Possibly take action on requirement for opening abandoned county roads:' Present in court was a group from the Dixon Baptist Church represented by Bobby Pickle asking the Court for help with the rock for CR3126, grading work has already been completed. This group will be constructing a community retreat on 14½ acres which will be used by church groups, family groups, boy scouts, etc.. Judge Bobbitt to check with the State on Interlocal Governmental Agreement with Pct 3 and non-profit organization. Item placed on OLD BUSINESS next meeting.

6636 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved request for Pct 2 to advertise for rock hauling for remainder of FY 1996-97.

_____ Judge Bobbitt reported that there was a water leak at the annex CPS office.

6637 On the motion by Martin, second by Green, the Court approved accounts payable.

6638 On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved line-item budget transfers.
