The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

- 667/ On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved a resolution in support for the efforts of the Sulphur Valley Water Supply Corporation to obtain a new water source for this area. Dale Brown with Hayter Engineering of Paris, Texas was present in court explaining the proposal of building a reservoir between Wolfe City and the Gober Community which would supply water to the North Hunt County Water Supply Corporation, Ladonia Water Supply Corporation and Wolfe City Water Supply Corporation.
- 600 On the motion by Martín, second by Ralph Green, the Court approved the Fire Protection Agreement Contract between the Volunteer Fire Department and Hunt County. According to Emergency Management Coordinator-Dorsey Driggers this contract will be the same amount of money, same group and the same amount of support as last years.
