She handed out copies of Supreme Court rulings on similiar court cases. Judge Bobbitt suggested that they proceed with the scheduled meeting with the Planning & Zoning Commission-if any immediate action is required then the County Attorney will be contacted; otherwise group must go through the hearing process.
