Regular Session Commissioners Court Meeting June 8, 1998

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

OLD BISINESS:

Possibly take action on request for additional funding for Justice of the Peace Court Clerk-Pct.3- Anita Hunter:' The Court discussed what would be required for the remainder of this budget year to fund clerk at \$5.15 per hour to allow this office to remain open from 8am to 5pm. The budgetary authority remaining in the current budget is \$1,013; additional budgetary authority needed to fund clerk until next budget year is \$2,358. The Court also noted a slight decrease in revenues collected as compared to this same time last year. Due to lack of a motionitem dropped from the Agenda.

6897 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Allen Martin, the Court approved resolution to join with Denton County in support of the inmate reimbursement legislation which would help alleviate some of the burden on taxpayers for providing the high cost of food, clothing, shelter, medical & other expenses for persons convicted of criminal wrongdoing when many have the ability to pay all or a portion of their per diem costs of confinement. The costs of incarceration should be borne by those whose conduct has earned it rather than by Hunt County taxpayers. Judge Bobbitt to prepare the resolution & circulate to the Commissioners.

6899 On the motion by Green, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved the preliminary plat for the Adam's Acres Subdivision in Pct.2 (which will require a section of road to be built) located in the William O'dell Survey A-816 & John J Hart Survey A-481.

6900 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Jim Walker, the Court approved proposed Administrative Services Agreement for the 1998 Texas Community Development Program for the upgrade on the water & sewer system for Town & Country Estates. The Court awarded administration of the contract to C & K-Consulting-represented in court by Ms. Steve Kerbow and the engineering of the project to Eddie Daniel Engineering. Mr. Daniel stated to the Court his firm has received approval of the grant in the amount of \$250,000 for this upgrade. Judge Bobbitt stated all fees & services will be held totally within the perimeters of the grant funding; all phases & focus will be paid entirely out of the grant funding with no liabilities being paid by Hunt County. When the grant monies are sent to Hunt County the Auditor . will set up an account & will pay all expenses through accounts payable.

6901 On the motion by Green, second by Walker, the Court approved bids on the following 63 re-sale properties which have had minimum bids pre-approved by all involved taxing jurisdictions, with the exception of R44312 (Ben Kinder explained to the Court-this house was struck off to GISD & they chose not to pre-approve minimum bid until they have idea of the amount of the bid.)
