Regular Session Commissioners Court September 28, 1998

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this date with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved with correction on #7707 to be CR4402 in Pct 4 per the Courts approval.

OLD BUSINESS:

70/9 On the motion by Ralph Green, second by Allen Martin, the Court renewed fire contracts with the Volunteer Fire Departments, the contracts reflect the increaseed amount from the county to each district by an increase of \$450 for each district, making a total of \$2000 per month for each Volunteer Fire District. Both Buel Bentley-President of Fire Association and Dorsey Driggers-Emergency Management Co-ordinator were present in court for discussion.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 'Discuss and possibly take action on formation of Sheriff's Posse:' Don Anderson & Phillip Killgore were present in court to discuss organization of posse made up of 15 volunteers, some will be certified/some non-certified officers which would be used at parades, county fairs, patroling parking lots, used in man-hunts, search efforts when a child is lost, etc., making this good PR for the Sheriff's Office, as well as the County. No county money would be required, each individual would provide their own horse, equipment, transportation of horse, etc. As to the liability factor, even though each member will sign a release form, the county will have the same liability as each regular employee during normal working hours, which will extend into the posse hours. The Court agreed to research this issue-placed on OLD BUSINESS next court meeting.
- **7020** On the motion by Martin, second by Jim Walker, the Court approved request to renew our option on County Choice Health Insurance which begins October 1, 1998.
 - 'Discuss & possibly take action on county trapper position:' After the court heard from several county residents on both the pro & con issues concerning whether or not to increase the salary of the county trapper-Ronnie Dickens \$400 a month or to reinstate the bounty system due to the State cutting back, the Court agreed to continue investigating this item as it needed additional information before a decision is made. Also present was Paul Mathews stating he is going to Austin to discuss this issue while there. Judge Bobbitt advised the residents that our tax rate has already been set for FY 1998-99 and that the funds would have to be allocated by the Court from some source. Placed on OLD BUSINESS for next court meeting, with notice to be posted and in the paper.
 - 702/On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved proclamation for the 4-H Youth Development Program National 4-H Week as October 4-10, 1998 as presented to the court by Carol Dale-4-H Leader.
 - On the motion by Green, second by Martin, the Court approved road upgrade of 262' dirt to rock for CR2472 & .25 mile of rock to asphalt on CR2667 in Pct 2.

 On the motion by Green, second by Thornton, the Court approved the preliminary plat for Caddo Creek Estate subdivision in Pct 2 developed by Nicholas Feldman which has 380ac./44 tracts, a 5000' road, restricting to new double wide mobile homes.
 - 7024 On the motion by Walker, second by Martin, the Court approved the request from GTE Southwest Inc. to construct a communication line within the ROW of CR3701 & 3702 in Pct 3 with the usual stipulations.
 - 7025 On the motion by Walker, second by Green, the Court approved the request from GTE Southwest Inc. to construct a communications line within the ROW of CR3131 & 3134 in Pct 3 with the usual stipulations.
