7019 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Allen Martin, the Court accepted the annual report from the Hunt County Historical Commission and approved the possible appointment of Commission member-Marjorie Moore as presented by Judy Woods. The Historical Commission also presented the Court with a Distinguished Service Award.

"Discuss & possibly take action on resolution asking the Historical Commission to keep the Ende-Gilliard house as a recorded Texas Historical Landmark: Judge Bobbitt placed item on <u>OLD BUSINESS</u> next court meeting.

1017 On the motion by Kenneth Thornton, second by Ralph Green, the Court approved request of Greenville Electric for the ROW on CR 1067. Jimmy Dickey stated standard procedures would be followed with the usual stipulations.
