The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS:

7/08 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Allen Martin, the Court approved reinstatement of the Ende-Gaillard House as a recorded Texas Historical Landmark after its historical status was revoked due to the relocation of the house to its present location at the Cotton Museum. The Court further declared Thursday-January 28, 1999 as Ende-Gaillard House Preservation Day.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discuss presentation by the Texas Animal Health Commission: Inspector John Miracle was present in Court to discuss this state funded agency dealing with all phases of animal agriculture, which is currently occupied with livestock disease control and irradication programs of infectious diseases. This agencys purpose is to work with counties sharing pertinent and important information concerning education and awareness of current programs, furthermore if a county residents animal have a disease that can't be diagnosed they can contact this commission for assistance for a response team which will come out and test animals. This commission will also help with the disposal of animals.
