

Regular Session
Commissioners Court
February 22, 1999

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 7137 On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Jim Walker, the Court approved the proposed 24 month lease agreement for the county employees parking lot, located directly east of the courthouse, for the same rate (\$350 per month/\$8,400 for 2 years).
- 7138 On the motion by Ralph Green, second by Walker, the Court accepted bid for recycled asphalt from Recycled Aggregates of Bridgeport, Tx., originating from Garland, Tx.. Bid on file in the Auditor's office.
- 7139 On the motion by Green, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court accepted bid for recycled concrete from Recycled Aggregates of Bridgeport, Tx., originating from Garland, Tx.. Bid on file in Auditor's office.
- 7140 On the motion by Martin, second by Walker, the Court approved request from United Telephone Co. to bury communications cable along ROW of CR 4412 in Pct 4 with the usual stipulations.


— The Court went into Executive Session at 10:15 am; the Court went back into Regular Session at 10:25am.

- 7142 On the motion by Green, second by Walker, the Court approved line-item budget transfers.


PERSONNEL & PAYROLL:

Tax Collector:	Remove Corrine M. Hancock, effective 2-12-99.
Community Supervision & Corrections Dept.:	This department has entered into a Computer Service Agreement with Hunt County which will allow computer support through our current system at the cost of \$15,000 per year, to be paid in 24 bi/monthly payments of \$625, with the first payment due 3-15-99, with like payments being made on the 15th & the last day of each month. This agreement effective 3-1-99. *No Comp time charged to the County in off hours.
