

SPECIAL SESSION
COMMISSIONERS COURT
MARCH 29, 1999

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00am with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Also present were Mr. & Mrs. Wiseman, Constable-Cullen Smith, JP Pct 4-Hershey Barnett, Tax Collector-Joyce Barrow and County Attorney-Peter Morgan. The purpose of this special called meeting was to 'Discuss and possibly take action on purchase of property in south Hunt County for the purpose of a sub-courthouse.' After much discussion, the Court agreed to the following:

7173 On the motion by Ralph Green, second by Jim Walker, the Court approved the purchase of the old Post Office located in Quinlan, Texas for the purpose of a sub-courthouse by entering into a contract in compliance with Texas Law and by paying \$500 in earnest money to Mr. & Mrs. James Wisemen. To allow time to locate budgetary authority-final action to be taken next court meeting. Commissioner Thornton to investigate the foundation. Motion passes on unanimous vote. Court Adjourned.
