Regular Session Commissioners Court September 13, 1999

The Hunt County Commissioners Court met this day at 10:00am with all Commissioners present and Judge Joe Bobbitt presiding. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved with changes added.

## NEW BUSINESS:

- 733/On the motion by Allen Martin, second by Jim Walker, the Court approved title to quit claim deed to property R54190 (struck off to Hunt County) located at 1200 Park Street, Commerce, Tx. to the Commerce Public Library to provide additional space needed for parking, which will benefit the entire community.
- 7332 On the motion by Judge Bobbitt, second by Kenneth Thornton, the Court approved 20 hours of continuing education for Delores Shelton-County Treasurer.
- 7333 On the motion by Thornton, second by Martin, the Court accepted bid from Richard W. Lyday for the sale of (1) used bridge deck for Pct 1. Bid on file in the Personnel Office.

- Discuss & possibly take action on the County Trapper's report: The Court heard report from county trapper-Ronnie Dickens stating he had killed 280 coyotes, 110 beavers and other miscellaneous animals, due primarily to the weather changing which causes animals to start moving, coming in from the outside counties.
- Discuss & possible take action on Duncan Thomas request for personnel re-alignment-Place on OLD BUSINESS next meeting.
- 7343On the motion by Martin, second by Walker, the Court authorized the county auditor to seek proposals for financing of computer imaging system for payroll & financial records.
- On the motion by Martin, second by Thornton, the Court approved Hunt County Pct 4 purchase from R.L. Longshore, Jr. and wife for the property adjacent to the county barn in Commerce, Tx. for \$55,000 and that the Longshores be allowed to rent the house on this property for a period of time up to December 31, 1999 for \$266 per month.
- 7345 On the motion by Thornton, second by Green, the Court approved continuence of the burn ban until next Commissioners Court. For: Thornton, Green. Against: Martin, Walker, Judge Bobbitt. After much discussion the court agreed that the saturation level has not been reached.
- 734% On the motion by Martin, second by Walker, the Court voted to left the burn ban, with consideration on Thursday or Friday of a continuence. For: Martin, Walker, Judge Bobbitt. Against: Thornton. Motion passes. Judge Bobbitt instructed the newsmedia to make all persons aware-due to lack of any additional rain the burn ban will be re-instituted on Thursday or Friday of this week.
